



ROUND TABLE DISCUSSION: Interesting Case Report – Videos/Papers

The Round Table Discussion(s) will be included in the clinical session. The Round Table discussions will be a meeting of peers for discussion and exchange of views.

Criteria:

1. Please recognize that rarity is not a reason in itself for submitting a case report; but rather there should be learning points or lessons.
2. The title of the abstract should be transparent.
3. The sections of the abstract should include: Introduction/background; clinical case (to include diagnostic evaluation, treatment and follow up); clinical lesson(s)/conclusion.
4. The conclusion should emphasize the learning point(s) and implications for practice.
5. Avoid the use of non-standard abbreviations. Too many abbreviations, especially non-standard ones make the abstract difficult to follow.
6. For laboratory parameters, the units of measurement and normal ranges must be provided.
7. Statements about ongoing studies or pending results should be avoided.
8. References should be kept to a minimum.
9. Presentation should be no longer than 8 minutes total.

The videos and papers submitted for the Round table will be reviewed and the chosen author will be invited to participate in the round table. This round table is a separate submission from the general session abstract submission.

When submitting a video or paper for the Round Table Discussion, please send a short 300 word description of the case, you will then mail the video on disc or USB to the American Hernia Society. Changes to the video once submitted are prohibited.

When submitting the 300-word description, please send the abstract and presentation form to carol@goddardassociates.com for consideration in the Round Table discussion session.

Deadline for submission is October 1, 2011. All rules must be followed in order to submit, any incomplete submissions will not be considered.
